9th CONFERENCE OF AIBOA - KARNATAKA SUCCESSFULLY HELD AT BENGALURU - YOUR GENERAL SECRETARY COM. K. RAGHAVA, RE-ELECTED AS THE PRESIDENT: The 9th Conference of Karnataka State Committee of AIBOA was held on Sunday the 18th August, 2019 at Bengaluru. The spacious and majestically decorated auditorium of Hotel Citadel, the venue of the Conference was virtually over flowing with the enthusiastic participation of more than 340 delegates and observers adding colour and gaiety to the Conference. All our Office-bearers and Managing Committee members from the State of Karnataka attended the Conference as delegates. From Our Organisation, being the biggest unit of the State Committee more than 200 delegates participated in the Conference and made it a grand success!

The Conference was inaugurated by Com. S. Nagarajan, General Secretary, AIBOA with your General Secretary, Com. K. Raghava, presiding over. Com. S. Com. Chandrashekar R., Joint Secretary from Bengaluru Region as the Joint Secretary. Com. H.R. Suresh, Com. Girish Kumar Bhat, Com. Durgaprasasd Rao T, Com. H.D. Suresh and Com. Madhumathi Pai, Regional Secretaries from Bengaluru Region have been elected as the Central Committee members.

The Conference also re-elected Com. A.B. Shetty as the Chairman and Com. Manish Chouhan as the new General Secretary of the State Committee. The Conference concluded with thunderous slogans hailing the unity of AIBOA / AIBEA / working class.
