- A) ENHANCEMENT OF REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES ON TRANSFER OF PERSONAL BELONGINGS BY ROAD**
- B) REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES FOR USING THEIR OWN VEHICLE ON OFFICIAL DUTY OUTSIDE THE STATION**

* * * * *

Our Industry is slowing proceeding to become officer-centric one. Rotational Transfers are effected on completion of three years in a Station besides promotional placement also on regular basis.

2. In our earlier COD submitted in June 2017 (8th Joint Note), we have demanded that the reimbursement of expenses for transporting the personal belongings should be delinked from the wagon load concept and substantial increase in the reimbursement of expenses per kilometer by road.

3. Our organization observed two days strike in March 2022 to halt the privatization of Public Sector banks and also sale of IDBI to private and foreign investors besides resumption of discussions on our residual issues. Responding to the directions from Labour Authorities, discussions were held by IBA with Officers' and workmen Organisations in **April, July and September 2022**. One of the issues placed for discussion was the enhancement of reimbursement of expenses for transport of personal belongings by road on transfer, as the earlier one considered by was **from 1.04.2011**.

4. It was assured in the meeting held with officers' on 31st Jan 2023, by IBA that the positive improvement would be considered for the benefit of the officers. IBA vide their circular dated **1st Feb, 2023 conveyed that rates have been revised which is as under:**

- a. The tonnage continued to remain the same for both categories of officers.**
The rate per kilometer per tonne up-to 1000 kms is **enhanced** from Rs.2.80 to **Rs.5.90** and beyond 1000 kms from Rs.2.00 to **Rs.4.25**.
- b.** In case an officer is transferred to shorter distance of up-to 300 kms the reimbursement is permitted upto 300 kms.

3. Officers transferred to and from hilly terrains will be reimbursed **two times** of the applicable rate **for distance covered** in the **hilly terrains** and **for the rest** as per the **above mentioned rates**.

B. REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES FOR USING OWN VEHICLE ON OUTSTATION DUTY:

Officers are reimbursed the expenses incurred by them for using their own vehicle for outstation duty. The rate of reimbursement per km **was fixed with effect from 1.10.2011**. In the meeting held by IBA on 13th April, 2022, after our two days strike in March 2022, we had raised the issue of enhancement of reimbursement of expenses for using their own vehicle for official duty.

Now, IBA, vide their communication dated **1st February 2023**, has enhanced the rate of reimbursement per KM. The details as under:

| 1. 4 wheeler - 1000cc or more | Rs 9.00 to Rs.11.00 |
| 2. 4 wheeler- less than 1000cc | Rs 7.00 to Rs. 9.00 |
| 3. Motor cycle and scooter | Rs.4.50 to Rs. 6.00 |
| 4. Mopeds | Rs 3.00 to Rs. 4.00 |

The effective date advised by IBA was **w.e.f 1.02.2023**.

We shall keep you posted with the developments from time to time.
