With the accruals available in our trust and also by the financial Assistance provided by the **management of The SVC Co-operative Bank** and the **officers' association** affiliated to our organisation HQs at Mumbai, AIBOA extended the financial assistance to the following members of adivasis community. The financial assistance was handed over by Com. O. Prajith Kumar, Chairman, Com. V. Jayagopal President, Com. H. Vinod Kumar General Secretary, and Com. K. Sathianathan Advisor to AIBOA(Kerala State Committee). **The beneficiaries are:**

- **Com.Sathyan**, handling painting work, who lost his right leg due to infection, was provided with a **three wheeler scooter** worth of **Rs.1,35,000.00** for commuting and win the bread for his mother, who is staying with him.

- **Miss. Suvarna**, D/o. Mr.Chandran & Mrs.Sindhu, a daily wager working in the forest department, was the first one who has completed the Graduation and also the College Topper in **B.COM** was given financial support of **Rs.10,000.00**, besides financial assistance of **Rs.1,00,000** was also given to complete the partially completed house, to safe guard them from anti-social elements in that area.

The function was attended by 30 local residents, which was organized by Com.P.C.Babu, former AIOBA Secretary Wayanad district, though he was indisposed off due to severe fever, couple of days prior to the function. The function was presided over by Sri. Abdul Gafoor, Municipal Councilor Sulthan Bathery municipality. The noble approach of community concern DEMONSTRATED by AIOBA , Sri. Padmanabhan,Taluk Library Council Member greeted the participants on the occasion.
