**PROCEEDINGS OF THE 5TH CENTRAL COMMITTEE MEETING
HELD AT RJS BHAVAN, MAMALLAPURAM ON 4TH & 5TH APRIL 2026**

The commencement of the 5th Central Committee was by hoisting the flag of AIBOA by Com. Anil Kumar, Vice-chairman, Com. A.N. Suresh, President and Com. S. Janakiraman, Secretary, TIBTUR at 10.30 am followed by the floral tribute to Com. Tarakeswar Chakraborty by the Central Committee. Subsequently, the comrade, who continue to live in hearts of bank officers irrespective of the affiliation – Com. RJS – was also paid due respect by the participants.

2. The proceeding of the committee commenced at 11.00 am by the joint presidium consisting of Com. V. Anil Kumar, Vice-chairman, Com. A.N.Suresh, President, Com. Ashwani Kumar Saini & Com.Gurminder S. Oberoi, Vice-presidents.

3. Com. D.S. Ganesan, President, AIBOA, TNSC presented the welcome address in a brief manner and set the tone for the conduct of the business listed in the agenda.

4. IN MEMORIUM

Shri Ajit Pawar, Deputy CM, Maharashtra, Shri Suresh Kalmadi, former Union Minister, Shri Kabindra Purkayastha, former Union Minister, Shri K.P. Unnikrishnan, 6 time Parliamentarian, Com.V.S. Anantha Subbarao, former Vice President, AITUC, Com.R Nallakannu, Veteran Communist Leader, Com. Ajay Ghosh, Leading Sr.Counsel for Labours and TUs, Shri T.K. Oommen, Renowned Sociologist, Dr.Gargi Chakravarthy, Eminent Historian, Shri Devendra Singh Garcha, Olympic Gold Medalist Hockey, Shri Dharmendra Legendary Bollywood Actor, Shri Utsav Charan Das, Folk dance exponent of Ghoda Nacha, Com. Ashwini Pradhan, Vice President, AIBOA, Com.T.V.Alwan.

5. The minutes of the 4th Central Committee Meeting held at Bengaluru on 16th & 17th of December 2025 was placed by Com. D.S. Ganesan, DGS, AIBOA which was unanimously adopted by the Committee.

6. Reporting of the Developments – action taken report:

- The committee was apprised of the efforts taken by the central office in pushing back the dis-investment exercise by Government of India pertaining IDBI and RRB.
- The three member committee constituted for unification exercise could not make any forward movement.

- The 3 officers' organization which triggered the call for strike in the month of March 2025 focusing on dis-investment of the Government equity in IDBI / PSBs along with the other issues was briefly presented.
- On 14th of February 2026, to enhance the reach of our organizational communications, the social media team headed by Com.D.S. Ganesan was launched as per the decision of the Bengaluru CC.
- The pending case at the Supreme Court right from March 2020 is to be further followed up for speedy disposal with regard to merger of banks (BOB + Dena Bank + Vijaya Bank).
- The membership break-up from the affiliates as well as from the State Committees need to be speeded up in view of the ensuing 9th National Conference at **Thiruvananthapuram** on 8th & 9th August 2026.
- The excellent observation of the strike on 27th of January 2026 preceded by the Conciliation Proceedings on 21st January, 23rd January & 24th January 2026 were attended by the office bearers of AIBOA as well as President AIBOA-MSA. Subsequent to the strike, there were two hearings held on 11th of March and 24th of March before Dy.CLC, Mumbai.
- The foundation day of our organization as well as release of the book of one of our active supporter Late Dr. Bando Upadhyaya was released by Bank of Maharashtra Officers' Association.
- Foundation conference of UPGBEA & UPGBOA was held at Aligarh on 27th of February 2026 preceded by the joint Central Committee AIGBEA & AIGBOA.
- A special meeting was held at Jammu on 17th of February 2026 in the matter of All India J & K Officers' Association at the instance of late Com. Ashwani Pradhan.

7. **Arrangement for the 9th National Conference at Thiruvananthapuram:**

- Com. Vinod Kumar. H, General Secretary, AIBOA-KSC explained in detail the preliminary arrangements made for the conference at Thiruvananthapuram.
 - a. The arrangement for the stay at **Thiruvananthapuram** will be from 7th August 2026, 1.00 pm to 9th August 2026 up to 12.00 pm.
 - b. The booking will be on the basis of advance payment by the State Committees.
 - c. The complimentary breakfast will be provided by the Hotel.
 - d. As the conference venue is 5 kms from the central point of stay, five buses will be arranged to pick up & drop the participants.
- **The logo for the conference was unveiled by Com. V. Anil Kumar, Com. A.N.Suresh and Com. S. Janakiraman. The logo depicts the influence of technology on human assets as well as the need for halting the Foreignisation of Indian Financial System.**

8. Com. Riyaz Bhat reported the efforts towards the unification exercise for the benefit of the participants and appealed to continue the process to achieve the desired results in the interest of the officers' community. The CC should consider release of an appeal to those units for aligning and strengthening AIBOA movement. Six CC members expressed their concurrence for the submission made by Com. Riyaz Bhat.

9. The CC had the benefit of releasing the book written by Com. D. Ramesh, former active member of AIBOA from E-Andhra Bank of his experiences in visiting various places in the Globe by the Presidium.

10. **Amendments to the bye-law:** The CC had the benefit of the information /suggestions made by Com. G.S. Oberoi, member of the bye-law committee, Rajasthan State Committee, BOMOA and MPBOA. The General Secretary emphasized that the focus should be on enhancing the Subscription as per the recommendation, reduction of the office bearers, introduction of punitive clause for non-implementation of the decisions of the organization by the State Committees and clarity in the matter of exercising the franchise in electing the office bearers in the conference. In all, 21 CC members expressed their candid views on the proposed amendments as well as expedited exercise to complete the process of unification in the background of emerging attack on the officers.

11. The 1st day session concluded at 7.45 pm.

12. The leave of absence of office bearers and central committee members were granted.

13. **The following decisions arrived at unanimously are as under (bye-law):**

- ❖ The affiliation fee fixed at Rs.100/- has been enhanced to Rs.1000/- for new units.
- ❖ The enhanced subscription payable per member by the affiliated units will be Rs.80/- and Rs.100/- to Central Office and State Committees respectively.
- ❖ The payment of subscription by the affiliates should be made on or before 31st of January of the subsequent year.
- ❖ Mode of selection / election of office bearers will be specifically incorporated.

14. **Other decisions arrived at by Central Committee:**

- a. Efforts will be invested to give the much needed representation for the working officers in forming the team of office bearers in the ensuing conference. Also, appropriate representation to lady comrades shall be ensured.
- b. Logistics support will be extended to the affiliated units / state committees in conducting the training programs pertaining to Disciplinary action by the central office of AIBOA.
- c. An appeal to those units to fall in line with the process of unification in the background of mounting attacks on the officers on their rights and privileges.
- d. Delegate fee of Rs.2000/- along with the list of participants should be sent to the AIBOA-KSC.
- e. In view of the various procedural steps to be adhered for enhancing the pages in our house magazine "TWO ROSES", the existing practice will be continued. On receipt of the articles written by the comrades in Hindi shall also be included for publication.
- f. The state committees, where ever the conference is due / over-due should complete the same on or before 15th of July 2026 failing which the state committees will not have the right of exercising the franchise.
- g. The financial obligations – subscription and wage revision levy should be remitted on or before 30th of April 2026.

- h. An amount of Rs.25.00 lakhs will be provided from the central office to AIBOA, Kerala State Committee in phases for the smooth of conduct of the conference and surplus, if any, should be returned back.
- i. All India Punjab National Bank Officer Employees' Union has sought financial help of Rs.5.00 lakhs against which Rs.2.00 lakhs was sanctioned by the Central Committee as a hand loan for conducting their organizational activities.

15. FELICITATIONS:

Com. J.P. Shaw, Joint Secretary, AIBOA and Com. O. Prajith Kumar, Secretary, AIBOA, on account of their superannuation from the services of the Bank in the month of April & May 2026 were felicitated by the Central Committee.

16. Presentation of the memento by AIBOA-TNSC, the host unit. Visualizing the need of unified functioning in the background of amendments of labour laws which are against the interest of the work force, the replica of the labour-statue was presented.

The two-day session ended at 01:30 pm with the address by Com. V. Anil Kumar, Vice-chairman.
