MERIT SCHOLARSHIP FOR MEMBERS' CHILDREN-2017 - RESULTS

Members are aware that we have called for entries from the members to compete for the Merit Scholarship for the academic year 2017, wherein the outstanding children of the members who have secured highest percentage of marks in S.S.L.C/Equivalent examination and Pre-University/Equivalent examination are to be awarded with merit scholarship for pursuing higher education. The last date for the receipt of the entries was fixed as 19th August 2017. According to the scheme, the first five applicants who have secured highest percentage of marks in the order of merit in S.S.L.C/Equivalent examination will be declared as successful candidates and will be awarded with the merit scholarship for their higher education. In case of PUC/Equivalent examination, there are three categories namely, science, arts and commerce. In the order of merit the first four in science category and the first two each in the arts and commerce categories who score highest percentage of marks will be declared as successful candidates and will be entitled to merit scholarship for higher education.

This year we have received 12 applications under S.S.L.C and 5 applications in PUC under science category, nil under arts and 3 under commerce categories respectively. The sub-committee headed by Com.Jagannathan M., Vice-President, which has been entrusted with the work, has scrutinized the applications received on the basis of merit and we are happy to declare the winners for the academic year 2017 as detailed below:
